Parking at the Inchnadamph Hotel, follow a track and path up the River Traligill, continuing to follow the watercourse north-east onto the ridge to the north-west of Conival. Continue to follow the ridge past the summit of Conival to the summit of Ben More Assynt, where the VP is located. Note: This VP should only be accessed if properly equipped and of a high standard of fitness.






FIGURE 4d - VP10: Ben More Assynt - Revised Layout
