Travelling from Dingwall, follow the A834 westwards for approximately 11km. Turn right onto the A835 and follow this road for around 16km until you reach Ben Wyvis car park, on the right side of the road. As described on the 'walkhighlands' website, park here and follow the path heading north, crossing the Allt a' Bhealaich Mhòir via a footbridge. After the bridge the path turns right, following a stream. The first section of the walk is through forestry, becoming more open after 2km. There is a steep ascent until a shoulder is reached, becoming more gentle before reaching the top of An Cabar, where the viewpoint is located. Access to this VP requires appropriate equipment and a good standard of fitness.






FIGURE 8.57.4 - VP 23: An Cabar (Ben Wyvis)




FIGURE 8.57.5 - VP 23: An Cabar (Ben Wyvis)
