# **CHAPTER 6: SCOPE AND CONSULTATION**

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## A.6. SCOPE AND CONSULTATION

### A.6.1 Introduction

- A.6.1.1 Chapter 6 of the EIA Report (January 2019) describes the pre-application consultation process that was undertaken to determine the scope of the EIA Report, and the consultations that were undertaken to inform the local community of the proposed variation. The Chapter also included a brief description of the environmental features of potential significance associated with the Proposed Varied Development which were addressed in detail in the EIA Report, and those that were scoped out.
